Adherence to Sections 889 & 1260H of the US National Defense Authorization Act

Sections 889 & 1260H of the United States National Defense Authorization Act places restrictions on IRC's use of technology produced by certain companies, Video surveillance and telecommunications equipment or services produced or provided by an entity that the United States Secretary of Defense determines is owned by, controlled by or connected to the government of the People's Republic of China.

Currently the following technologies are restricted:

1. Telecommunications equipment or services produced by:
 - I. Huawei Technologies Company,
 - II. ZTE Corporation, or
 - III. any of their subsidiaries or affiliates.
2. Video surveillance and telecommunications equipment or services produced by:
 - I. Hytera Communications Corporation,
 - II. Hangzhou Hikvision Digital Technology Company,
 - III. Dahua Technology Company, or
 - IV. any of their subsidiaries or affiliates.
3. Video surveillance and telecommunications equipment or services produced or provided by an entity that the United States Secretary of Defense determines is owned by, controlled by, or connected to the government of the People's Republic of China.
4. Any products from the Chinese "military companies" according to the list in Appendix G. In 2026 these now include, for example, Alibaba, BYD and TP Link, amongst others.
