

Data protection notice for the processing of your personal data in procurements at the Deutsche Bundesbank

The personal data you provide will be used by the Deutsche Bundesbank (Wilhelm-Epstein-Strasse 14, 60431 Frankfurt am Main, Germany, tel.: +49 (0)69 9566 0, email: info@bundesbank.de) in compliance with statutory data protection regulations solely for the fulfilment of your legal and (pre)contractual obligations. This includes, for example, the tendering and award procedure as well as the performance and processing of any contracts concluded as part of the tendering and award procedure. Personal data are processed on the basis of Article 6 (1) letter b) of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), with regard to employees in connection with Article 88 GDPR and § 26 of the German Federal Data Protection Act (Bundesdatenschutzgesetz - BDSG), and Article 6 (1) letter e) of the GDPR in conjunction with section 3 of the German Federal Data Protection Act.

The data are stored as long as they are required for the tendering and award procedure, the performance and processing of the contract as well as the fulfilment of contractual and/or legal obligations.

The recipients of the data are auditors, chartered accountants, technical planners, architects, etc. who have been commissioned by, or are contractually bound to, the Deutsche Bundesbank.

Under certain preconditions, you have the following rights regarding your personal data vis-à-vis the Deutsche Bundesbank:

Right of access (Article 15 GDPR)

Right to rectification (Article 16 GDPR)

Right to erasure ('right to be forgotten') (Article 17 GDPR)

Right to restriction of processing (Article 18 GDPR)

Right to data portability (Article 20 GDPR)

Right to object (Article 21 GDPR)

In addition, pursuant to Article 77 of the GDPR, you have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority regarding the processing of your personal data.
