

Eligibility Evaluation

“Environmental survey and Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) for Shore Crossing”

Status: 18/08/2026

I. General information

The contracting authority intends to invite **four** applicants to submit an initial offer.

In the event that there are more than four companies that meet the minimum requirements criteria as specified in Procedure Letter No. 1, a maximum of four companies will be selected using the selection criteria described below. Applicants will be ranked based on the scoring below, and the top four applicants will be invited to submit an initial offer.

Applicants who are not among the top-ranked candidates will no longer be considered for the further procurement procedure and will be informed promptly. In the event that two or more applicants achieve identical scores affecting the selection of the top four, the final determination among those tied applicants will be made by drawing lots.

II. Selection criteria

The selection among eligible applicants is based on the quality of references in accordance with the requirements of **Attachment A.1** (Forms and Proofs (Eligibility)) and Procedure Letter No. 1.

The applicant will receive points for each reference that fulfills the following requirements – that also counts for additional references according to No. 4 in the table below. An applicant can earn a maximum of 63 additional points in total:

3	Points will be awarded for demonstrated experience in environmental surveys for linear infrastructure projects in the German North Sea coastal region, combining islands, Wadden Sea and the coastal marshland.	5 per reference (up to 6 references are counted)
4	If an additional reference fulfills the minimum requirement, it gets a point (up to 3 additional references are counted).	Max 3 additional references
