Declaration of Commitment to Comply with Data Protection Requirements under the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

I/We _____

was/were informed of the obligation to comply with data protection requirements under the GDPR and the Federal Data Protection Act (*Bundesdatenschutzgesetz – BDSG*).

Accordingly, it is prohibited to process personal data without authorization. Personal data may only be processed if consent or a legal provision permits the processing, or if the processing of this data is required. The principles of the GDPR for processing personal data are set out in Article 5 (1) GDPR and essentially include the following obligations:

Personal data must be:

1. Processed lawfully and in a manner transparent to the data subject (“lawfulness, fairness, transparency”),
2. Collected for specified, explicit and legitimate purposes and not further processed in a way incompatible with those purposes (“purpose limitation”)
3. Adequate, relevant and limited to what is necessary in relation to the purposes for which they are processed (“data minimization”),
4. Accurate and, where necessary, kept up to date, all reasonable steps must be taken to ensure that personal data that is inaccurate with regard to the purposes for which it is processed is erased or rectified without delay (“accuracy”),
5. Stored in a form that permits identification of data subjects for no longer than is necessary for the purposes for which the data is processed (“storage limitation”),
6. Processed in a manner that ensures appropriate security of the personal data, including protection against unauthorized or unlawful processing and against accidental loss, destruction or damage, using appropriate technical and organizational measures (“integrity and confidentiality”).

Violations of this obligation may be penalized with fines and/or imprisonment. A violation may also constitute a breach of contractual employment obligations or specific confidentiality obligations. Additionally, (civil) claims for damages may arise from culpable breaches of this obligation.

This obligation continues even after the termination of the activity.
